NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a resolution, the summary of which is published herewith, has been adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Amsterdam, New York on February 18, 2026, and the validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which said Town is not authorized to expend money, or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution. Such resolution shall be kept available for public inspection at the office of the Town Clerk during normal business hours for twenty (20) days following the publication of such summary as provided in the Local Finance Law.

SUMMARY OF RESOLUTION NO. 36 - 2026

BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF AMSTERDAM, NEW YORK (THE "TOWN"), DATED FEBRUARY 18, 2026, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF AN INTERNATIONAL MODEL HV5074-SFA TRUCK FOR THE TOWN OF AMSTERDAM; ESTIMATING THE AGGREGATE COST THEREOF TO BE \$301,277.42; APPROPRIATING UP TO \$301,300.00 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF INDEBTEDNESS IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$301,300.00 TO FINANCE SAID COST.

The Town Board of the Town (the "Board") adopted a resolution authorizing the purchase of a new International Model HV5074-SFA Truck for the Town (the "Truck"), at a cost estimated to be \$301,277.42; and

The Board reaffirmed its authorization for the purchase of the Truck, the maximum aggregate cost thereof being hereby estimated to be \$301,277.42 and appropriated said amount therefor and authorized the issuance of serial bonds or a statutory installment bond in an amount not to exceed \$301,300.00 (the "Indebtedness") to finance such cost.

It was determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid Truck is twenty (20) years pursuant to Section 11.00(a)(27) of the Law.

The plan of financing for the Truck includes the issuance of \$301,300.00 serial bonds or a statutory installment bond (the "Indebtedness") and the levy of a tax upon all the real property in the Town to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same shall become due and owing.
